# **Committee Reports:**

Lawnmower still researching and comparing different models, will need to look at funding options before purchasing. Police, new patrol vehicle has been delivered but waiting to have equipment installed. Strutz moved, Harris second to approve step increase for Officer O'Brien due to successful completion of probationary period, carried. Landfill options discussed as current (and final) cell is at full capacity. Possible options were to close site completely or contract with waste company to have roll-off containers delivered and used for disposal of inert waste. Purchasing land and moving the site was not an option due to Department of Health regulations, Township Ordinances and cost of land. The Department of Health will allow the current site to be used for disposal of burnable items, recyclable metals and compost. Sitzler moved, Strutz second to close Oakes Inert Landfill effective immediately, carried. Strutz moved, Harris second to approve proposal from Gahner Sanitation to begin having roll-offs available for inert waste

disposal effective June 1; compost pile will be open regular summer hours for month of May, carried. New hours and rates will be posted by June 1.
