Unfinished Business:

Brummund Storm Invoice, Kuipers moved, Rosendahl second to approve payment of \$1,900 for clean-up of July 2011 Storm to Brummund Construction. Roll call: Sitzler-no, Forward-yes, Harris-yes, Kuipers-yes, Rosendahl-yes, carried.

Committee Reports: **Development**, Sitzler is in discussions with Dahlstroms regarding the extension of water and sewer to proposed new home and requests to change streets in that area; more will be decided once quotes are obtained for construction. **Garbage**. Harris requested the old cylinder from the garbage truck be rebuilt and have it scheduled to be swapped with current cylinder on an annual basis; Nelson will check on prices. **Cemetery**, committee has met and has plans for a clean-up day and other improvements; some repairs have already been completed. Any gravestones needing repairs have been noted and will be placed on a schedule to be repaired; any stones that have been chipped will not be repaired. **Fire**, Chief Hollingsworth reported the generator has been connected and a door replaced; the Fire District plans have been placed on hold until later this year. **Landfill**, Nelson reported that by this fall we will be beginning the first stages of closing the landfill due to full capacity; requested Council to continue searching for possible alternatives. **Dethlefsen Chiropractic** has asked permission to build a handicap accessible entry way into the sidewalk, no action was taken until more information and other options have been presented. **Dangerous Building**, Bill Geffre has asked for forgiveness of the final payment for the demolition of 411 Main, the remaining payment is \$7,000. No action was taken, he is still to be invoiced. Water Treatment **Plant Operator**, Rosendahl moved, Kuipers second to approve step increase for Kevin Haring for passing certification of Grade 01 operator, carried.

New Business:

Special Event Permits, Forward moved, Sitzler second to approve special event permit for American Legion on June 9 at the rodeo, carried.

Arbor Day Proclamation, Sitzler moved, Harris second to introduce and approve RESOLUTION DECLARING JUNE 1, 2012 AS ARBOR DAY, carried.

Unfinished Business:

Garbage Program, Nelson explained the concerns of using garbage truck to direct haul due to load restrictions on ND Highway 1; discussion of possibly installing a tag lift. Nelson will continue searching for prices and options. Discussion was held on purchasing recycling containers to begin self-service of recycling for the community. Sitzler moved, Forward second to allow garbage committee to implement and approve changes to garbage service, carried.
