Engineer Report:

2016-1 Lagoon Improvement, pre-construction meeting will be scheduled soon. Conklin moved, Engel second to approve Moore Engineering Invoice #15367 for \$3,042.50, carried. USDA requires special assessments to be created in order to secure loan, assessments will not be certified to property. O'Brien moved, Harris second to introduce and approve RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT OF LAGOON IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 2016-1, roll call approved.
