<u>Transfers:</u> Discussion was held regarding the transfer of CARES Act funds. Committees would like to discuss and explore further options before moving forward with transfers.

<u>Building Permit:</u> Harris moved, Bagley second to approve Scours Inc. permit, Lot 3 Block 8 Washburn's Addn, new duplex, carried.

Electrical, two electrical panels are attached to street light poles, they were intended to be only seasonal for summer events, talk with Chamber about removal.

A 2% cost of living raise was budgeted for 2021, Conklin moved, Harris second to approve the 2% increase, carried. Harris moved, O'Brien second to approve a step raise for Lee Bredeson to reflect his dedication and years of service, carried.
