

4.0305 Open Burning Prohibited

No garbage, refuse, or rubbish shall be burned within the city limits. This includes paper products, inert yard waste (leaves, branches, and other wood and organic properties) or an open burning fire of any nature. Burning is allowed only if there is an enclosed, approved UL certified outdoor fireplace or a special burn permit for large outdoor gatherings, such as a pit barbeque. Permits need to be approved by the Fire Chief and City Council. Fires must be attended at all times by a responsible adult until completely extinguished.

If burning is prohibited by state law or proclamation, no person shall kindle, maintain or burn any garbage or other refuse either openly or in containers.

Any person who violates the burning prohibition of Ordinance 4.0305 shall be fined One Hundred Dollars (\$100). Each and every violation of the provisions of Ordinance 4.0305 shall constitute a separate offense.
